## NPT divided?

### Recent Crises of NPT

- Humanitarian issue
- Middle East issues

### Structural factors: Crisis of 'grand bargain'?

- Gap over disarmament progress between NWS and NNWS: Inequality between NWS and NNWS
- Inalienable right of peaceful use 'OR' non-proliferation?

## Challenge to maintain the integrity of NPT Appropriately addressing peaceful use of nuclear technology can be a key to maintain the cohesiveness of the NPT

# Principles of peaceful use

- Peaceful use should improve the quality of life for all.
  - Making the peaceful benefit of nuclear technology available to anyone
- > Peaceful use should bring the stability, not increase the risks.
  - Responsibility for technology holders and aspirants to seriously consider measures to reduce concerns of their neighbors: Do not be naïve!

#### Transnational interests should be considered.

- Global implication of nuclear non-proliferation, security, and safety
- Contribution in coping with global issues such as climate change

# Keys for promoting peaceful use

- Multilateral cooperation is beneficial because of;
  - Bringing more confidence and transparency;
  - Further improving the capacity of nuclear governance; and
  - Promoting more appropriate/effective use of nuclear technology in terms of economy and purposes
- Under the current environment surrounding nuclear energy, '3S' has become even more critical.
- Beyond myth
  - Additional Protocol: non-proliferation vs national sovereignty?

# Japan's Commitment to Peaceful Use and 3S

### Critical elements...

Full compliance with IAEA safeguards and voluntary measures for transparency

#### Multilateralism

- > Japan as the first state to have applied IAEA SG in 1959
- Active commitment to the making of AP
- Integrated SG status: extensive investment in safeguards
- Financial contribution (eg. nuclear security and Peaceful use Initiative Fund)

#### What to be done more...

- Sharing lessons learnt from the Fukushima nuclear accident
- Providing cooperation for capacity building and nurturing cultures of '3S'
